



The 2019 Philadelphia Summer Championships will be conducted in accordance with the rules and regulations of U.S. Figure Skating, as set forth in the current rulebook, as well as any pertinent updates which have been posted on the U.S. Figure Skating website.

This competition is open to all eligible, restricted, reinstated or readmitted persons as defined by the Eligibility Rules, and is a currently registered member of a U.S. Figure Skating member club, a collegiate club or an individual member in accordance with the current rulebook. Please refer to the current rulebook for non-U.S. Citizens.

The 2019 Philadelphia Summer Championships is a participating competition of <u>Ice Men</u>.

This competition is also Sanctioned by Skate Canada and open to all eligible Canadian skaters.

NATIONAL QUALIFYING SERIES (NQS):

This competition has been approved by U.S. Figure Skating as an official NQS event. Athletes are required to read the NQS handbook <u>found here</u> and register for the series through <u>EMS</u> by May 28th (separate from competition registration).



ELIGIBILITY/TEST LEVEL:

Test level: Competition level is the highest test passed as of the entry deadline, in the discipline the skater is entering. Entrants may skate one level above that for which they qualify, but they may not skate down in any event.

Age restrictions/requirements: Singles free skate events (Well Balanced Program) have the following requirements.

Juvenile: Girls – 12 years or younger; Boys – 13 years or younger Open Juvenile: Girls – 13 years or older; Boys – 14 years or older Intermediate must be under the age of 18 Adults must be 21 years or older

Skaters entering pre-juvenile and lower events will be divided as closely as possible by age, should the number of entries warrant more than one group.

NQS REMINDER: All NQS events are combined short program and free skate events. If there are more than 24 entries per event, qualifying rounds must be held in accordance with Rule 2460.

NOTE FOR SKATERS: it is <u>not a requirement</u> for skaters to be registered for the NQS series to compete in these events.

Complete USA Eligibility

Eligible competitors for Compete USAQ events may be members of a Learn to Skate USA Program or full members, in good standing of U.S. Figure Skating. Eligibility will be based only upon highest free skate test level passed (Moves in the Field test level will not determine skater's competitive level). Skaters may skate at highest level passed or one level higher, but not both levels in the same event during the same competition. Skaters may not compete at more than one level in the same type of event at the same competition.

ENTRIES:

Entries will only be accepted online via EMS at <u>www.usfsaonline.org</u>. Online registration opens April 15, 2019 and closes July 1, 2019. Skaters wishing to register for the competition will need their U.S. Figure Skating member number and password.

A Consolation Short Program Round will be held for all skaters that do not make the Final round at each level.



FOREIGN SKATERS:

Non-U.S. skaters intending to register for this competition must set up a non-member account prior to registering for the competition (<u>click here for HOW TO</u>). This can be done by choosing the "Non-Member? Create Account" option on the <u>Members Only</u> login page.

PARTNERED EVENTS (Pairs)

Only one partner needs to complete registration for the team. During the registration process, you will be asked to identify your partner and verify their test information. The registered partner will be responsible for managing all aspects of the competition for the team including music/PPC upload, practice ice sales, etc.

REGISTRATION INSTRUCTIONS:

- 2. Enter your U.S. Figure Skating or Learn to Skate Member number and password

- 4. Click "Competition Registration"
- 5. Choose 2019 Philadelphia Summer Championships from the list of competitions.

EMS SKATER PORTAL:

Once online registration has been completed, skaters will gain access to the EMS Skater Portal for this competition. This is where you will manage music and PPC upload as well as purchase practice ice, view the competition schedule (once available) and update coach information. To access your skater portal, click the **BLUE** Event Management System button on the <u>Members Only</u> landing page then select the competition name from options at the bottom of the screen.

REFUND POLICY: No refunds will be given unless no competition exists or the event is canceled. There will be no refunds for medical withdrawals.

SCHEDULE: Competitors may be scheduled on any day or time for the announced dates of the competition. The competition and practice ice schedule will be available via EMS as soon as possible after the close of entries. A **tentative schedule** will be posted at <u>www.lceWorkssc.org</u> to assist with travel plans. All participants will be notified via email once available.

FACILITIES: The competition will be held at IceWorks Skating Complex 3100 Duttons Mill Rd, Aston, Pennsylvania 19014. Phone (610) 497-2200. <u>www.iceworks.net</u> The complex has 3 ice surfaces measuring 85' X 200' and one measuring 100' X 200'. All rinks have rounded corner and hockey barriers. Locker rooms will be available for use by skaters in each rink.

The complex features a full service café, a pro shop, a game room, and Pub and Grill.

MUSIC UPLOAD:

DEADLINE: July 9, 2019 Late Music upload fee: \$25.00

All competition music must be electronically submitted via the EMS Skater Portal through the Music & Program Content tab no later than July 9, 2019. All music must meet the following criteria. If you have questions about what format you have, please contact your coach and get a new version of your music that meets the criteria listed below.

- File Format: MP3 (only format EMS will accept)
- Bit Rate: 192 kbps or higher and Sample Rate: 44,100 kHz

- This will be verified by the music chair and they may request you upload a corrected file
- Leaders and trailers (the silence or "dead space" before and after the actual start and end of the program music) may not exceed two (2) seconds. We prefer that there be NO leaders or trailers at all. Excessive leaders and trailers may disrupt the playing of the music during competition.

Competitors must also bring a copy of their competition music on CD as a backup in case of technical difficulties and must be available rink side during the competition. Only CDs (standard CD-R format only) will be accepted for backups and must be clearly marked with the competitor's name, event, and running time.

LIABILITY: U.S. Figure Skating, IceWorks Skating Club and IceWorks complex accepts no responsibility for injury or damage sustained by any participant in this competition. This is in accordance with Rule 1600 of the official U.S. Figure Skating Rulebook.

OFFICIAL NQS SINGLES EVENTS:

Intermediate – Senior Combined Short Program + Free Skate Juvenile Free Skate

*These events will be conducted in accordance with U.S. Figure Skating Rule 2460 with regard to qualifying and final rounds if more than 24 competitors register.

A CONSOLATION ROUND for all skaters that do not make the final round will be held. The consolation round will be the SHORT PROGRAM and is included in your registration fee.

CRITIQUES:

Critiques for IJS Pre Preliminary, Preliminary, Pre Juvenile, Open Juvenile and Adult Gold, Silver and Masters will take place after their free skates. Critiques for IJS Juvenile and above will be held in accordance with the guidelines for critiques for NQS events. ICEMEN:

The 2019 Philadelphia Summer Championship is a 2019 Icemen designated competition. All male skaters who are registered members of the Icemen program are invited to attend the Icemen social held in conjunction with the competition. Details regarding the Icemen social will be posted on the <u>www.iceworkssc.org</u> with date and time as well as registration process. Please note that this information will not be up until early July. Skaters not yet part of the program may register for social event as well.

<u>REGISTRATION</u>: Registration will begin on Monday July 29, 2019 and end at Saturday August 3, 2019. Registration will be open one before the first event and run through the last event of the day. The registration table will be located Main Lobby. Please register promptly upon arrival.

<u>PRACTICE ICE</u>: All practice ice will be available for purchase online through the EMS Skater Portal. A timeline for practice ice sales periods will be available for viewing on the Main page of your skater portal. <u>AWARDS</u>: Medals will be given first through fourth place. Awards will be given first through fourth for combined events.

<u>OFFICIAL NOTICES</u>: An official bulletin board will be maintained at the registration desk in the main lobby. It is the responsibility of each competitor, parent and coach to check the bulletin board frequently for any schedule changes and/or additional information. Skaters are requested to arrive 45 minutes prior to the scheduled time of their event. A tentative schedule of events will be posted prior to the competition.

TEST CREDIT: Skaters that meet the requirements for test credit may request their test credit forms at registration. Forms must be picked up at the registration desk prior to the end of the competition. Skaters must fill out a form for test credit at time of registration.

TICKETS AND CREDENTIALS:

Each competitor will receive one credential plus one chaperone and one coach credential. Additional credentials for coaches will be at the cost of \$35.00. Entrance fees for all spectators of the event will be \$5.00 per day and \$25.00 for the entire week of the 2019 Philadelphia Summer Championships and International Competition as well as Collegiate Championships.

IMPORTANT NOTICE FOR ALL COACHES:

To be a credentialed coach at a sanctioned nonqualifying competition, <u>coaches must be included within a skater's</u> <u>registration or updated through their EMS Skater Portal.</u> All coach compliance is verified via EMS and is connected to the U.S. Figure Skating database. This event is a standard U.S. Figure Skating Nonqualifying Competition (EMS) MC 3/1/2019

- Completed SafeSport Training* (for coaches 18 years old and over)
- Completed background check (green light status) (for coaches 18 years old and over)
- Learn to Skate USA Instructor Certification completed (for coaches under 18 years old)

*SafeSport training is available through <u>http://www.usfsaonline.org</u> for full members of U.S. Figure Skating (through Learn to Skate USA portal for instructors). There is no cost to this training and certification is valid for 2 seasons

The LOC will have a list of compliant coaches via EMS, verified through the U.S. Figure Skating database who are approved to receive a credential at the competition. Coaches will need to check in at the event registration desk and show a government issued photo I.D. to receive a credential.

If a coach cannot provide a photo I.D. and is not on the list or cannot produce the necessary documents, he or she will not be allowed a credential. There can be <u>no exceptions</u> to this policy.
